

List B - Mixed Feed List

All samples entering the United States must be clearly identified. An itemized list identifying all samples in each shipment is required. (List A.) Additionally, if any of the samples are a **mixture or blend of multiple ingredients** (compound feeds, grain mixtures, total mixed rations, supplements, premixes, etc.), all of the ingredients in the mixture must also be itemized and identified. For example, submitting a grain mixture labeled "Dairy Feed" is insufficient. All of the individual ingredients in the "Dairy Feed" must be listed, such as:

DAIRY FEED

Shelled corn

Soybean meal

Gluten feed

Beet pulp

Molasses

Limestone

Dicalcium Phosphate

Vitamin A

Vitamin D

Vitamin E

Complete (List B.) for each mixed feed. (List B.) must be included along with (List A.) describing all of the samples in the shipment.

It is advisable to print all lists (List A. and List B.) on your Company Letterhead. You may photo copy (Lists A. and B.) onto your company letterhead stationary.

Following these guidelines will ease the passage of your samples through US Customs.

Note: It is illegal to ship animal byproducts or samples containing animal byproducts. Shipments containing animal byproducts will be returned or destroyed by US Customs.
